Encyclopaedia Britannica,	Encyclopaedia Britannica, 14th edition, 1929. Twenty-four volumes, blue, good condition. This edition of the Britannica has an interesting history. Produced between the highly-regarded 11th through 13th editions, which were noted for their thorough and sometimes gritty coverage of many issues, and the 15th and later editions which dropped coverage of many issues in order to include more 20th century topics, the 14th edition was unlike either its predecessors or its successors. Some critics assert that the 14th edition was intended to avoid offending anyone—at least in the English-speaking portion of the world—and therefore does not display the same candid approach taken in the 11th through 13th editions. “Regrettable incidents” in religious history, especially, were glossed over or eliminated and the stories of some important figures were cleaned up. The contributions of women were less likely to be highlighted in the 14th edition, and other entries were altered to reflect the political considerations of the aftermath of WWI. Reaction to the 14th edition’s effort to please everyone was decidedly negative among many scholars, and sales of the edition were also hurt by the onset of the Great Depression. Nevertheless, the 14th edition preserves a unique perspective that is less likely than the earlier editions of the Britannica to find its way onto websites and digital archives.
